Program Description

The Alton Success Academy is made up of three components. All three components work together to serve students who have been recognized as truant and/or in need of an alternative educational placement. The Alton School District has a centralized truancy program. All truancy for the district is handled through the Alton Success Academy.

The Alton Success Academy also provides a Night School program for those students who are truants, chronic truants, retrieved dropouts, potential dropouts, or teen parents. Throughout the year, approximately 200 students receive educational services through the Night School program.

The final piece of the Alton Success Academy is the alternative School. This program serves students between 6th and 9th grade. Grade level instruction is provided so that students will be academically prepared to transition back to their home school. An important piece of this program is the behavioral interventions component which teaches the students to deal with situations differently, thus allowing them to successfully return to their home school. .
