Program Description

The Madison Student Support Center houses an optional education program that targets alternative education and teen mom services. In this program, students receive daily attendance monitoring, weekly individual counseling sessions, weekly art therapy, daily aggression replacement training, balanced and restorative justice activities, credit recovery assistance, and small class sizes.

MSSC also provides supplemental services to students, grades K-8, that meet the criteria for truant, chronic truant, and/or potential dropout. Students that are identified are placed on an early interventionist's case load and provided the following services: social skills, instruction, counseling, and academic/attendance monitoring. In addition, credit recovery services are offered to those students that are credited deficient and meet the criteria for truancy at the high school level.
