Program Description

Quincy Public Schools has developed a comprehensive program to provide academic, social-emotional, career-vocational and parent/guardian/family support to students who are truant and chronically truant, as well as those who have dropped out of high school or are at-risk of dropping out. The goal of the TAOEP program is to improve the academic performance and attendance of students, as well as to enhance their sense of connection to the school and its personnel. The students served within this program, are in grades 7-12, attend three sites: Quincy Junior High School, Quincy Senior High School and Irving Alternative. The academic services to be provided include academic counseling, tutoring, participation in credit recovery program online curriculum, and summer school academy. The non-academic services to be provided include: court-related services, day care services, health-related services, home visits, life skills training, mentoring, monitoring, parenting classes for students, personal counseling, referral for social/academic services, parents/family support services, and transportation. The career-related services to be provided include: career service and work experience. TAOEP supplemental services will ensure: 1). Individualized service plans for students; 2). Tutor/mentors and tutor/counselors to provide home visits, counseling, mentoring and monitoring; 3). Apex course curriculum within school or extended-day or extended-year programming.
