Program Description

The Regional Attendance Cooperative is the only program to support the truancy intervention efforts of the schools in Boone and Winnebago County area excluding Rockford School District #205. After the intervention efforts of the school has not brought about change, students are referred to the program where an individual plan for each student is determined to use available community resources to address the root cause of the truancy and assist the student/family to have a successful school experience.

The Regional Learning Center provides alternative/optional education to students 16 to 21 years of age, who reside in Boone or Winnebago County and have experienced school failure which has led to excessive absenteeism, or dropping out of school. We also seek to provide the support services from community agencies to meet the needs of our students so they may become productive citizens upon completion of the program.
